



Code of Conduct of Coaches and Staff

All coaches, assistant coaches and trainers shall be of the highest moral and ethical character in order to teach our youth the best skills of soccer. They shall meet all criteria to coach for Clash, know the Laws of the Game, USSF directives, GYSA Rules and Modifications. Coaches are responsible for the sporting behavior of their parents and guests. Negative reports sent to the D&P Chair, will be dealt with immediately.

They shall treat all guests, spectators and visiting coaches staff with dignity and respect during all Clash/GYSA events. They shall represent Clash in the highest regard possible.

They shall conduct and include in all of their training sessions; technical and tactical skills, safety, fair play and good sportsmanship. The coach shall come prepared for training using approved and accepted practices from recognized training material, e.g. USSF/FIFA or NSCCA.
