



CLASH POLICY FOR PLAYER PRACTICE PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

The basis for this policy is referenced in GYSC Rules and Regulations 530.3e, f, g, h. These sections outline player playing time based on meeting player practice participation requirements set by the club (Clash Soccer).

Rule 530.3e, Recreation relating to playing time for U6, U8 and U10. They play half of each half as a minimum per game meeting the requirements below.

Rule 530.3f, Select relating to playing time. They play a minimum of half of the game meeting the requirements below.

Rule 530.3g, U19 teams are not required to meet the minimum playing time.

Rule 530.3h, coaches are responsible for carrying out the GYSC policy based on our practice requirements.

Practice Requirements;

1. To practice, players must be properly registered and in good standing with the club.
2. Every effort should be made by the player to attend mandatory team practice(s).
3. Practice participation is defined by players arriving at practice on time, properly dressed, and actively participating in all activities by following the coaches' instruction and giving effort equal to their abilities.
4. It is the player's responsibility to contact the coaching staff or team manager if they miss a practice. They should inform the coaching staff as soon as possible with the reason and when they anticipate returning to practice.
5. Reasons for excused absences are; sickness, injury, academic requirements, required travel by player. Excessive unexcused absences may cause the player to be dismissed from the team.
6. The team's coach will name the team's starting lineup and award playing time based on factors that include practice participation.
7. Player may appeal coach's decision to the DOC.
