



INCLEMENT/SEVERE WEATHER AND NOTIFICATION POLICY

This policy is adopted to protect the health and welfare of our participants and guests attending Clash functions and games.

1. The president or his designee(s) has the authority to cancel, suspend or postpone any match, practice or function due to inclement/severe weather or due to other circumstances.
2. Inclement /severe weather is any weather event or combination of weather events forecasted, approaching or occurring on our fields that warrant immediate activation of safety measures to protect our people and fields, or deemed to be inappropriate for the function or age group(s) participating.
3. Upon receiving a forecast or alert of inclement /severe weather, the president or his designee(s) shall immediately attempt to notify coaches, referees, referee assignor, team managers, and parents of the weather conditions and changes. They may use any or all of the following communication tools, CLASH information line (**770-387-5351**), email, phone calls, texting, or CLASH web site, or if on the fields verbally warn all participants.
4. It is the responsibility of coaches, managers, parents, players and referees to be alert to the possibility of inclement /severe weather for their game/practice by checking the notification alert process in #3. Players traveling need to check the field conditions of the teams they visit.
